King James Version

Colossians 1

14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

New International Version

Colossians 1

14 In whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

NOTE: The omission of through his blood is a serious doctrinal matter. The blood/death of Jesus was a requirement of the forgiveness of sins.

KJV

1 Timothy 3

16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

NIV

1 Timothy 3

16 Beyond all question, the mystery of godliness is great: He appeared in a body, was vindicated by the Spirit, was seen by angels, was preached among the nations, was believed on in the world, was taken up in glory.

New American Standard Bible

1 Timothy 3

16 By common confession, great is the mystery of godliness: He who was revealed in the flesh, Was vindicated in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Proclaimed among the nations, Believed on in the world, Taken up in glory.

NOTE: Here are 2 examples showing the destruction of the divinity of Christ, His divine nature and human nature being combined is lost. So would be our hope of victory over sin and salvation. GOD manifest in the flesh. To say 'He' is not specific and can relate to anyone, all men are manifest in the flesh but the KJV clearly notes that God was. Time and time again the modern versions attack Christ and His nature, position, lordship.

KJV

II Timothy 4

1 I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom

NIV

II Timothy 4

In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who will judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I give you this charge:

NOTE: The judgment is AT a definite time. Little differences it may appear. But after many of these you have BIG doctrinal changes.

KJV

Job 19

25 For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:

26 And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God:

New American Standard Bible

Job 19

25

"As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives,
And at the last He will take His stand on the earth.

26

"Even after my skin is destroyed,
Yet from my flesh I shall see God;

NOTE: The NASB clearly promotes spiritualism. This is going to be one of the major problems in the end times. We cannot afford to use a translation that will lead to deception.

KJV

I Peter 4

6 For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit.

NIV

1 Peter 4

6 For this is the reason the gospel was preached even to those who are now dead, so that they might be judged according to men in regard to the body, but live according to God in regard to the spirit.

NOTE: God Himself in His Word says the dead know nothing. The gospel is not preached to people after they are dead. The KJV is clear throughout about the spiritually dead who need quickening (conversion/spiritual awakening), not the literal dead as the modern versions take it. This is another satanic effort to promote spiritualism. This is an example of how subtle some of the changes are which cannot be seen except by careful study. Some are so subtle I would not dare to present them to prevent further confusion.

KJV

2 Thessalonians 2

2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

NASB

2 Thessalonians 2

2 that you not be quickly shaken from your composure or be disturbed either by a spirit or a message or a letter as if from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come.

NIV

2 Thessalonians 2

2 not to become easily unsettled or alarmed by some prophecy, report or letter supposed to have come from us, saying that the day of the Lord has already come

ESV

2 Thessalonians 2

2 not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by a spirit or a spoken word, or a letter seeming to be from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord has come.

NKJV

2 Thessalonians 2

2 not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Christ had come

NOTE: The day of the Lord is clearly denoted as the 2nd coming of Christ, all these modern translations are in error. More dangerous is that, that would mean there is no 2nd coming. The words 'has come', 'has already come', and 'had come' are past tense. The true word of God has a future with the glory of the second coming..

KJV

Mark 7

19 Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?

NIV

Mark 7

19 For it doesn't go into his heart but into his stomach, and then out of his body." (In saying this, Jesus declared all foods "clean.")

NASB

Mark 7

19 because it does not go into his heart, but into his stomach, and is eliminated?" (Thus He declared all foods clean.)

ESV

Mark 7

19 since it enters not his heart but his stomach, and is expelled?"(Thus he declared all foods clean.)

NKJV

Mark 7

19 because it does not enter his heart but his stomach, and is eliminated, thus purifying all foods?"

NOTE: Once again all the modern translations agree here in error. The modern versions add a note that all meats are clean contradictory to Lev. 11. Notice the parenthesis adding words that Jesus didn't say or mean. We are in the day of atonement. The Bible clearly says that any man that defiles the temple him shall God destroy. The KJV prepares its readers for a cleansing of the soul temple as required before the day of atonement/close of probation.

KJV

Luke 2

33 And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him.

NIV

Luke 2

33 The child's father and mother marveled at what was said about him

NASB.

Luke 2

33 And His father and mother were amazed at the things which were being said about Him.

ESV

Luke 2

33 And his father and his mother marveled at what was said about him.

NOTE: The KJV in its accuracy titles this verse appropriately and the modern versions call Joseph, His father, when in fact the God of Heaven is His Father.

DIRECT ATTACKS ON ADVENTIST DOCTRINES

This is only a small sample of the verses which have direct implications against Adventist doctrines. Pound for pound or dollar for dollar, SDA doctrine cannot be proved through a modern version (a Catholic Bible). The KJV is the only Bible the Catholic Church doesn't sell or authorize its use, in its stores or churches. This is why so many Adventists are confused (babeled) in the midst of the church. We explain things by tradition as opposed to by showing it out of direct explanation of the Word, because we know what it is supposed to say. The modern versions contradict themselves because of the errors, so one area may appear OK but in another there is theological confusion. Remember the Devil usually won't make big changes as to alarm people, so he alters a little here and a little there until the foundation is a shifting sand.

KJV

Exodus 20

10 But the seventh day is the sabbath of the LORD thy God: in it thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that is within thy gates:

NIV

Exodus 20

10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates.

NASB

Exodus 20

10 but the seventh day is a sabbath of the LORD your God; in it you shall not do any work, you or your son or your daughter, your male or your female servant or your cattle or your sojourner who stays with you.

ESV

Exodus 20

10 but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates.

NOTE: The 7th day Sabbath is not a sabbath like the feast days/sabbaths of Leviticus 23 which identify that the day of Atonement, feast of Unleavened Bread, Passover, etc are sabbaths. The 7th day is the Sabbath, the definite article is singular and specific, the memorial of creation. The problem is brought to a head in Romans, Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Colossians, Hebrews, where Paul is explaining about the ceremonial laws that are 'ceased' Dan 9:27 by the death of Christ.

KJV

Ephesians 2

15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;

NIV

Ephesians 2

15 by abolishing in his flesh the law with its commandments and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself one new man out of the two, thus making peace,

NOTE: The NIV makes the error that the 10 commandments are done away with by this wording but notice the KJV says “contained in ordinances” which delineates that this is the ceremonial law. A problem which can be amplified in the next verse below.

KJV

Colossians 2

16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days:

NIV

Colossians 2

16 Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day.

NASB

Colossians 2

16 Therefore no one is to act as your judge in regard to food or drink or in respect to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath day—

ESV

Colossians 2

16 Therefore let no one pass judgment on you in questions of food and drink, or with regard to a festival or a new moon or a Sabbath.

NOTE: 2 BBBIG problems here:

The Sabbath is the 7th day and is not a ceremonial sabbath. The ceremonial sabbaths are listed in Lev 23. The context of the words meat and drink refer- to meat offering and drink offering see verse 37, etc. Once again the translators of the modern versions have the meaning of the verse destroyed because it is not talking about things you eat at a meal. What is clean and unclean food was established in Genesis, Leviticus, and Deuteronomy and a change of such would mean that God’s Word has a contradiction which Peter understood in Acts 10 was not the case.

KJV

Daniel 8

14 And he said unto me, Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed.

NIV

Daniel 8

14 He said to me, "It will take 2,300 evenings and mornings; then the sanctuary will be reconsecrated."

NASB

Daniel 8

14 He said to me, "For 2,300 evenings and mornings; then the holy place will be properly restored."

ESV

Daniel 8

14 And he said to me, "For 2,300 evenings and mornings. Then the sanctuary shall be restored to its rightful state."

NOTE: This verse all by itself destroys ALL biblical doctrines if taken as true in the modern versions. Cleansed is not equal to –reconsecrated or properly restored or rightful state. Webster’s New International Dictionary 1941 Defines--Cleansed: to render clean, to free from filth, pollution, infection, guilt, sin. Reconsecrated: to make or declare, sacred or holy, to appropriate to sacred uses, to set apart or dedicate or devote, to the service or worship of God. These words do not have the same meaning. The modern versions are in error here in translation and doctrine.

KJV

Hebrews 9

3 And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all;

4 Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;

8 The Holy Ghost this signifying, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:

12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

NIV

Hebrews 9

3 Behind the second curtain was a room called the Most Holy Place, 4which had the golden altar of incense and the gold-covered ark of the covenant. This ark contained the gold jar of manna, Aaron's staff that had budded, and the stone tablets of the covenant.

8 The Holy Spirit was showing by this that the way into the Most Holy Place had not yet been disclosed as long as the first tabernacle was still standing.

12He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.

NOTE: There are many problems in this one chapter destroying the plan of salvation which is shown through the sanctuary. These changes cannot be made without destroying the context of Chapter 9 then entire biblical doctrine.

1---The golden censer and the altar of incense are two different things. The altar of incense as per the old testament is in the holy place not the most holy. Ex 30:6,7

2---In verse 8 the word here in Greek, hagian which means holy place is used in the plural. The context of the word here is referring to the sanctuary(holy and most holy places), to note it as the most holy place singular is an incorrect translation and destroys Bible doctrine. Notice the beginning of the chapter starts the context of a tabernacle with holy and most holy places (sanctuary v.1/tabernacle v.2). Verse 3 in Greek, Paul uses the word hagian- twice to signify most holy place. But in v.8 when he says "the holiest of all" his context refers to the heavenly sanctuary. "First tabernacle"v.8 the "worldly"v.1 implying there is a 2nd heavenly sanctuary please remember an epistle must be read in context and throughout Hebrews Paul is contrasting old/new covenant, levitical/Christ priesthood, worldly(earthly)/heavenly sanctuary.

3---Once again you look at the Greek here the context and use of the word is plural and denotes that the holy place is the heavenly sanctuary holy and most holy places together not most holy singular.

KJV

1 Peter 3

18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:

NIV

1 Peter 3

18 For Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit,

NASB

1 Peter 3

18 For Christ also died for sins once for all, the just for the unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit;

NOTE: The nature of Christ for eternity is combined with human flesh this is destroyed here in this verse, here they have Him living as a spirit. Luke 24:36- 40 Jesus shows His disciples that He is indeed alive in the flesh, not as a spirit.

THE LITTLE HORN'S OBVIOUS ATTACK ON THE BIBLE -2 VERSES

KJV

2 Peter 2:9

9 The Lord knoweth how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished:

SPECIAL NOTE:

The KJV is definitively in the future tense with the words: "to be punished." Note all the modern versions below are in the present tense some almost covertly like the NKJV other are blatantly in the present tense. What does this mean? You may have thought that it was a stretch to say that all modern versions are Catholic bibles but that is exactly what they are when you understand that as a student of the Word of God you are to take the words as they read and follow them especially as a Protestant. To not believe a part of the Bible, any part, is to be outside of the will of God and put the reader in a lost condition. Please know that the Catholic church itself uses II Peter 2:9 in their bibles as the proof text for purgatory. They can do that since they are authorizing these bibles and know that the KJV is not authorized by them or sold in their bookstores.

2 Peter 2:9 (New International Version)

9if this is so, then the Lord knows how to rescue godly men from trials and to hold the unrighteous for the day of judgment, while continuing their punishment.

2 Peter 2:9 (New American Standard Bible)

9 then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment,

2 Peter 2:9 (New King James Version)

9 then the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment,

2 Peter 2:9 (The Message)

9 So God knows how to rescue the godly from evil trials. And he knows how to hold the feet of the wicked to the fire until Judgment Day.

2 Peter 2:9 (New Living Translation)

9 So you see, the Lord knows how to rescue godly people from their trials, even while keeping the wicked under punishment until the day of final judgment.

2 Peter 2:9 (New Century Version)

9 So the Lord knows how to save those who serve him when troubles come. He will hold evil people and punish them, while waiting for the Judgment Day.

2 Peter 2:9 (New Life Version)

9 But the Lord knows how to help men who are right with God when they are tempted. He also knows how to keep the sinners suffering for their wrong-doing until the day they stand before God Who will judge them.

2 Peter 2:9 (New International Reader's Version)

9 So the Lord knows how to keep godly people safe in times of testing. He also knows how to keep ungodly people under guard until the day they will be judged. In the meantime, he continues to punish them.

ENDNOTE: This is how the beast will get all the world to wonder after them. You can only come to the same conclusion as your neighbor if your reading the same thing as your neighbor though the cover is deceiving by saying it is a different version. Get the protestant KJV Bible and come out of Babylonian theology.

ATTACK ON THE 10 COMMANDMENTS!!!

Revelation 22:14 (King James Version)

14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

Revelation 22:14 (New International Version)

14 "Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city.

Revelation 22:14 (Contemporary English Version)

14 God will bless all who have washed their robes. They will each have the right to eat fruit from the tree that gives life, and they can enter the gates of the city.

NOTE: I WILL NOT BELABOR THIS VERSE. TWO EXAMPLES ARE ENOUGH.

VERSION AFTER VERSION READS THE SAME IN THE MODERN VERSIONS. ROME'S LAST ATTACK IN THE WORD OF GOD AGAINST THE LAW OF GOD JUST BEFORE THE END OF THE BIBLE. THIS HAS BEEN A CRITICAL VERSE USE IN THE REVELATION SEMINARS THAT SDA'S HAVE DONE SINCE OUR LEARNING THE THREE ANGELS MESSAGE. IT IS AN INDISPENSABLE VERSE SHOWING THAT THE 10 COMMANDMENTS ARE STILL VALIDATE UP UNTIL THE LAST IN THE WORD OF GOD.

“And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.” DANIEL 7:25.

SPIRIT OF PROPHECY ON THE PAPACY'S ATTACK ON THE BIBLE

The following quotations from the Spirit of Prophecy validate the history that is presented in the two streams of manuscripts on the last fives pages of this document. These are only some of the evidences that can be seen in the Spirit of Prophecy. The first group of quotes show the

foolishness of man trying to change God's inspired Word, with the wisdom of man. The multiplicity of Bible versions is an attempt by the Papacy to undermine faith in the Word, to cause doubt on passages and cause confusion(babel).

I take the Bible just as it is, as the Inspired Word. I SM 17

The work of "higher criticism," in dissecting, conjecturing, reconstructing, is destroying faith in the Bible as a divine revelation; it is robbing God's word of power to control, uplift, and inspire human lives. {Ed 227.4}

Spiritual darkness has covered the earth and gross darkness the people. There are in many churches skepticism and infidelity in the interpretation of the Scriptures. Many, very many, are questioning the verity and truth of the Scriptures. Human reasoning and the imaginings of the human heart are undermining the inspiration of the Word of God, and that which should be received as granted, is surrounded with a cloud of mysticism. Nothing stands out in clear and distinct lines, upon rock bottom. This is one of the marked signs of the last days. {1SM 15.2}

This Holy Book has withstood the assaults of Satan, who has united with evil men to make everything of divine character shrouded in clouds and darkness. But the Lord has preserved this Holy Book by His own miraculous power in its present shape--a chart or guidebook to the human family to show them the way to heaven. {1SM 15.3}

There are men who strive to be original, who are wise above what is written; therefore, their wisdom is foolishness. They discover wonderful things in advance, ideas which reveal that they are far behind in the comprehension of the divine will and purposes of God. In seeking to make plain or to unravel mysteries hid from ages from mortal man, they are like a man floundering about in the mud, unable to extricate himself and yet telling others how to get out of the muddy sea they themselves are in. This is a fit representation of the men who set themselves to correct the errors of the Bible. No man can improve the Bible by suggesting what the Lord meant to say or ought to have said. {1SM 16.1}

These statements here all from the Great Controversy, are only some that validate the corruption of the Bible by the agents of the Papacy read the chapters in their entirety to get the complete picture. Note how the Waldenses were the preservers of the pure Word of God the "unadulterated" manuscripts which they possessed and were those eventually used by Erasmus (Antioch stream of manuscripts-47).

The Waldenses were among the first of the peoples of Europe to obtain a translation of the Holy Scriptures. Hundreds of years before the Reformation they possessed the Bible in manuscript in their native tongue. They had the truth unadulterated, and this rendered them the special objects of hatred and persecution. They declared the Church of Rome to be the apostate Babylon of the Apocalypse, and at the peril of their lives they stood up to resist her corruptions. While, under the pressure of long-continued persecution, some compromised their faith, little by little yielding its distinctive principles, others held fast the truth. Through ages of darkness and apostasy there were Waldenses who denied the supremacy of Rome, who rejected image worship as idolatry,

and who kept the true Sabbath. Under the fiercest tempests of opposition they maintained their faith. Though gashed by the Savoyard spear, and scorched by the Romish fagot, they stood unflinchingly for God's word and His honor. {GC 65.2}

While Luther was opening a closed Bible to the people of Germany, Tyndale was impelled by the Spirit of God to do the same for England. Wycliffe's Bible had been translated from the Latin text, which contained many errors. It had never been printed, and the cost of manuscript copies was so great that few but wealthy men or nobles could procure it; and, furthermore, being strictly proscribed by the church, it had had a comparatively narrow circulation. In 1516, a year before the appearance of Luther's theses, Erasmus had published his Greek and Latin version of the New Testament. Now for the first time the word of God was printed in the original tongue. In this work many errors of former versions were corrected, and the sense was more clearly rendered. It led many among the educated classes to a better knowledge of the truth, and gave a new impetus to the work of reform. But the common people were still, to a great extent, debarred from God's word. Tyndale was to complete the work of Wycliffe in giving the Bible to his countrymen. {GC 245.1}

A diligent student and an earnest seeker for truth, he had received the gospel from the Greek Testament of Erasmus. He fearlessly preached his convictions, urging that all doctrines be tested by the Scriptures. To the papist claim that the church had given the Bible, and the church alone could explain it, Tyndale responded: "Do you know who taught the eagles to find their prey? Well, that same God teaches His hungry children to find their Father in His word. Far from having given us the Scriptures, it is you who have hidden them from us; it is you who burn those who teach them, and if you could, you would burn the Scriptures themselves."--D'Aubigne, *History of the Reformation of the Sixteenth Century*, b. 18, ch. 4. {GC 245.2}

Tyndale's preaching excited great interest; many accepted the truth. But the priests were on the alert, and no sooner had he left the field than they by their threats and misrepresentations endeavored to destroy his work. Too often they succeeded. "What is to be done?" he exclaimed. "While I am sowing in one place, the enemy ravages the field I have just left. I cannot be everywhere. Oh! if Christians possessed the Holy Scriptures in their own tongue, they could of themselves withstand these sophists. Without the Bible it is impossible to establish the laity in the truth."--Ibid., b. 18, ch. 4. {GC 246.1}

Said(Queen of Scotland) Mary: "Ye interpret the Scriptures in one manner, and they [the Roman Catholic teachers] interpret in another; whom shall I believe, and who shall be judge?" {GC 251.1}

"Ye shall believe God, that plainly speaketh in His word," answered the Reformer; "and farther than the word teaches you, ye neither shall believe the one nor the other. The word of God is plain in itself; and if there appear any obscurity in one place, the Holy Ghost, which is never contrary to Himself, explains the same more clearly in other places, so that there can remain no doubt but unto such as obstinately remain ignorant." {GC 251.2}

And who can be one jot less strict without corrupting the word of God? Can any steward of the mysteries of God be found faithful if he change any part of that sacred depositum? No. He can abate nothing, he can soften nothing; he is constrained to declare to all men, 'I may not bring down the Scripture to your taste. You must come up to it, or perish forever.' {GC 260.1}

In the 1260 day time prophecy of Daniel and Revelation the Word has told us that God's people would be persecuted. We see from the history that first the Bible was taken from them, then those who had a Bible were attacked, because they understood the truth about SALVATION.

The modern versions we have today are CATHOLIC bibles reskinned. The scriptures above are only a sample of 100's more that have been changed or omitted. There are 17 verses completely missing with others having phrases or complete sentences missing, to numerous to list here, but one example is Matt 18:11. The devil knows if you have and study diligently the TRUTH you cannot be overcome. For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect. Matt 24:24 These bibles are types of false christs. How do you think the devil will get the whole world to worship the Beast? And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. Rev 13:8

The only true Word of God is translated off of the Textus Receptus. This is the greek manuscript from which the Bible the 1611 KJV was translated from. Which is confirmed in the history given in the Spirit of Prophecy. This is none other than the KING JAMES VERSION in the English language. If you speak or read in another language check to see that the Bible of that language is from the Textus Receptus greek manuscript. The manuscript is the original preserved copy of the writings of the Bible by the original prophets who wrote them. They are copies of the true originals which no longer exist due to time, age, usage. If you study the history of how the Jewish scribes made copies it was indeed with great preciseness and meticulous detail because they knew their eternal life depended on it. We know that the Bible has been preserved by God as He has promised in His word in many places. Psalm 12:7

In the following historical outline of the two streams of Bible Manuscripts(MSS) we can clearly track the history of the preserved Word of God in the Textus Receptus MSS and the counterfeit Hort/Westcott MSS which is from the Vaticanus MSS and Sinaiticus MSS. The Sinaiticus was found in the trash in a Catholic convent in Sinai and the Vaticanus has been in the Vatican for 1500 years. Please study the history in B. G. Wilkensen's book Our Authorized Version Vindicated. The following pages 46 is a historical overview of the streams of the manuscripts. The pure and the corrupted. Notice Antioch where Christians first received this name in Acts preserved the pure stream of the Bible. Alexandria is where we know the manuscripts were tainted/corrupted by subtracting and adding according to individuals preferences particularly by Clement and Origen. Notice 2 steps from Origen is the Vaticanus Manuscript, then 2 steps and work of Jerome, 2 more steps and the Rheims-Douay Bible a pure Catholic bible, 4 more steps the Tischendorf manuscript which was used by Hort and Wescott where we have our first modern bible version the RV--Revised Version, 1881.

Notice the Latin Vulgate, a Catholic Bible comes off the stream of MSS corrupted by Clement, Origen, Eusebius. These individuals added and subtracted from the scriptures according to their dislike of certain bible doctrines. They effectively helped to establish Catholic doctrines which through tradition after 1000's of years has come to be believed as truth. The Rheims-Douay

Bible which is a now established old Catholic Bible effectively agrees with all the Modern Versions because they all come off the same MSS stream.

Of the know manuscripts at this time of counting we had 5210 Traditional Text MSS and 45 Alexandrian Text MSS. The supporters of the modern versions base their Bibles off of text that are less than 1% of the MSS in the world. When the 5210 Traditional Text agree with the King James Version and one another. The Vaticanus and Sinaiticus differ in 1000's of places between themselves.
